

## **THE PRIVACY POLICY OF THE WEBSITE REBALTIC.LT**

The internet website (hereinafter referred to as the Website) is publicly available at [www.rebaltic.lt](http://www.rebaltic.lt). It is owned under the right of ownership and controlled by UAB “Rebaltic” (hereinafter referred to as the Company), legal entity’s code 302424303, the office address: Liejyklos str. 3, Vilnius.

### **I. COLLECTION AND STORAGE OF PERSONAL DATA**

The Company collects the following personal data for the purposes of direct marketing: first name, last name, email address, phone number. The procedure of registration is intended to express a consent on use of personal data for the purposes of direct marketing. Personal data are stored for a period of 5 years from the moment of their submission. The user may revoke this consent at any time by sending email to the website administrator to [info@rebaltic.lt](mailto:info@rebaltic.lt).

### **II. USE OF COOKIES**

2.1. When the user starts to use the Website of the Company expresses his agreement on the Company’s policy of use of cookies (hereinafter referred to as the Cookies), including their entry and use.

Cookie is a small piece of data recorded in the User’s computer or other terminal device when the User visits the Website. Cookie contains information that is placed in the Website. Information available in cookies is automatically analysed during a visit in the Website to adapt to the needs of the Company and the User. Information provided by cookies can be used to assess behaviour of the User in the Website and to provide him with promotional offers and (or) other services provided in the Website.

Session and persistent Cookies are used in the Website. Session Cookies are in the User’s computer (or other device) as long as the User uses the Website. It means that session Cookies are removed from the User’s computer (or other device) after the User leaves the Website. Persistent Cookies are administered for 5 years in the User’s computer (or other device).

2.2. Types of Cookies used:

a) mandatory cookies: they are necessary for a proper operation of the Website; they allow a comprehensive browsing in the Website and use of all of its functions;

b) performance cookies: they help to understand how the Website is used by the Users. They help to obtain information on the parts of the Website visited by the users, a time spent in the Website and any malfunction and interferences of the Website faced by the User while browsing in the Website;

c) functional: they help to remember what was selected or indicated by the User in the Website during the previous session, e.g. when the User starts entering the User name with the purpose of connecting to the System he is provided with the User name used by the User during the previous sessions;

d) purposeful or promotional cookies: they are used to provide the User with a content that would better match his interests. They also help to learn what type of the Company's advertising was seen by the User and when it was last seen, if, in general, such advertising was demonstrated for the User.

2.3. All Cookies used by the Company are anonymous. They allow recognize the Website User but do not allow to identify his personal identity.

2.4. The purposes of use of Cookies:

a) to enable the User to use all functions of the Website and the services provided in the Website of the Company;

b) to meet individual interests and needs of every Website User;

c) to ensure safety and privacy of the Website User;

d) to save the entry information in own tools and to speed up performance of the User's actions in the Website;

e) to save information on information and services the Website User is interested in, in order to provide the User with a purposeful information and advertising only;

f) to get aggregated data based on which the Company could assess how the Users use the Website and, on the basis of such data, to improve operation of the Website, to upgrade its structure and content.

2.5. Management of Cookies:

2.4.1. The User shall express his prior voluntary consent on permission to record Cookies by ticking a relevant box "I CONSENT" at the notification: "Please be informed that Cookies are used in this Website. Please tick a relevant "I consent" to express your consent. You can revoke your selection at any time by changing settings of your Web browser and deleting the Cookies recorded".

2.4.2. Most of Web browsers are set to automatically accept Cookies. Therefore, the User who does not consent on recording and administration of Cookies in this computer (or other device) may block or delete them by changing settings of his Web browser (they can usually be found in the menu of "Internet options" located in the Web browser toolbar item "Tools").

2.4.3. After having blocked and (or) deleted all or some Cookies the User still can use the Website. However, some functions of the Website and (or) the services provided in the Company's Website may become inaccessible by the User. Moreover, such User does not receive information tailored to his needs that is available in the Company's Website.

### III. RELATED WEBSITES

3.1. Links to other websites may be provided in this Website that will allow the User to leave the present Website in order to obtain information of the third parties or information of the third parties can be provided in the present Website (hereinafter referred to as the Related websites).

3.2. The Company cannot change, update or control a content of the Related websites. Therefore, the Company assumes no responsibility for correctness of a content available therein.

3.3. The User must note that the rules of use, privacy policy, provisions of confidentiality, the rules of management of personal data and other rules that differ from those valid in the Website may be valid in the Related websites.

#### IV. THE FINAL PROVISIONS

The present Privacy policy is valid from the 1st of July 2017. The Users will be notified in the Website on any changes in the Privacy policy.
